

Entering results in field events

Please note: Specific DQ-rules and warnings are set by Roster-support or the Secretary at each arena. So, when someone is disqualified: Note the DQ in the app and contact Roster-support firsthand and the secretary secondhand to help set the specific DQ-rule or warning (which is set as [‘Public notes’](#)).

LJ/TJ: Same volunteer that enters the results also enters the wind to the meet mgmt app (see example in the video).

When the judge confirms the results: **Mark the event as finished**

Field events without Pools (excl. HJ/PV)

In field events where there are no pools but only a straight final, the setup is simple. Always follow the order in the bottom of the screen.

- After 3 rounds the order will be changed, so the 8 best continues in the order: 8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 for the final three rounds.
- In events where we have combined multiple age groups in the same list, the 8 best from each age group will get the final 3 attempts. Follow the bottom of the screen all the time and everything will be correct.

Field events with Pools (except HJ/PV)

Note: In combined events where everyone has three attempts:

Pool A = P Pool 2 & Pool B = Pool 1

In field events with Pools the setup is a bit more complex.

After Final Confirmation each day before the next days events, every athlete will get a [‘Public note’](#) that explains what Pool they will jump or throw in. (all athletes need to be in the same start list to get a full and correct result list). The best seeded athletes will be in Pool 2. See example below on what Pool they belong to in the first 3 rounds.

P1-2, P1-2, P1-3, P1-4...

P2-1, P2-2, P2-3, P2-4...

For example: **“P2-3” = 3rd athlete in order for Pool 2**

Round 1-2-3: It is important to **only enter results on the athletes who are in your pool!** Pool 2 enters results for the following athletes:

P2-1, P2-2, P2-3 osv...

Round 4-5-6: When the 8 best athletes after three rounds will have the last 3 attempts. **Now the volunteer needs to change to only following the bottom of the screen!** The order is then 8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 for the last 3 rounds based on the results after the first 3 rounds.

See video with example on how a volunteer enters results for the 3rd round in Pool 2, followed by another volunteer that enters the 3rd round for Pool 1. Lastly, one volunteer enters results for round for 4 (by following the bottom of the screen).

HJ/PV

Height progressions are prepared and starting heights are set in Callroom Callroom so the field

events volunteers should not need to handle that.

In HJ/PV we have separated the events where multiple age groups competes simultaneously (eg. "M80+" with M80, M85 & M90). This is because the winner of each age group should be able to decide the last height without interfering the height progression for the other age groups that might not be finished. **That means that the volunteer need to change lists in Roster between the age groups.**

Note: In combined events the height progressions are followed strictly, so the winner is not able to decide the last height.

Note: In HJ/PV: Group A = Pool 2 & Group B = Pool 1

HJ/PV without pools

In HJ/PV where we don't use Pools, the setup is simple. **Set "✓" after each jump and follow the order in the bottom of the screen to see who jumps next.**

HJ/PV with pools

The winner of Pool 1 (group B) is not able to decide the final height (because that jumper is probably not the winner across the pools). **Pool 1 follows the height progressions strictly.**

Winner of Pool 2 (group A) is allowed to decide the last height! So the **volunteer needs to be able to adjust the last heights.** Please see video on how you can do it.
